System of raising fish and using their waste as nutrients for growing plants.






Plants purify the water, and the water is recycled back into the fish tank!

Site Plan – Corridor View




Site Plan – Tiered Approach




Site Plan - Tier I

Site Plan - Tier III




Site Plan – Tier IV
