Funding for ...

Local Food Promotion: Local governments may apply by **May 12**, 2016 for Farmers Marketing and Local Food Promotion Program (FMLFPP) grants from the USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service. The Local Food Promotion Program (LFPP) will award grants up to \$500,000 with a 25% match requirement for planning for, establishing, improving, or expanding local and regional food business enterprises. The Farmers Market Promotion Program (FMPP), will make grants of up to \$250,000 with no match required for the development, improvement, and expansion of domestic farmers' markets, roadside stands, community-supported agriculture programs, agritourism activities, and other direct producer-to-consumer market opportunities. The USDA/AMS published notices of both LFPP and FMP opportunities on March 8, 2016, as FFO numbers USDA-AMS-TM-LFPP-G-16-0001 and USDA-AMS-TM-FMPP-G-16-0002, respectively. Transit Buses and Facilities: Local governments that are Section 5307 Urbanized Area program recipients, or rural areas that are applying with the State of NC, may apply by **May 13**, 2016 for DOT/FTA's Buses and Bus Facilities grant program and Low or No Emission grant program. These two programs provide funding for, respectively: capital projects to replace, rehabilitate, purchase or lease buses and related equipment and to rehabilitate, purchase, construct or lease bus-related facilities (Bus and Bus Facilities, FTA-2016-002-TPM, \$211 million total pool), and (b) purchase or lease of zero-emission and low-emission transit buses, including acquisition, construction, and leasing of required supporting facilities such as recharging, refueling, and maintenance facilities (Low-No, FTA-2016-003-TPM, \$55 million total pool). Police: Local law enforcement agencies may apply by **May 16**, 2016 for funding to purchase bulletproof vests. There is a 50% match requirement, and registration in the US DOJ/Office of Justice Programs' Bulletproof Vest Partnership is required before funding can be applied for (at <http://ojp.gov/bvpbasi/home.html>.)

Rural Broadband Service: Local governments may apply by **June 17**, 2016 for the USDA/Rural Utilities Service's Community Connect Grant Program. This program will make grants of \$100,000 - \$3,000,000 to provide broadband service to currently unserved, lower-income, and extremely rural areas. This program was published by the USDA as Federal Funding Opportunity number RDRUS-CC-2016 on April 19, 2016. Neighborhood Revitalization: Local governments may apply by **June 28**, 2016 for Choice Neighborhood Implementation Grants from HUD. These grants will provide up to \$30 million to implement comprehensive revitalization plans that may include housing, social mobility, and other community development activities.
